Read This Before You Install

Gas and electric lanterns have different installation instructions – and flush mount vs bracket mount matters too.

Reading the correct section now ensures a smooth install and fewer surprises later.

The Two Most Important Details:

- **1. Gas vs. Electric Installation:** These are completely different make sure your installer reads the correct instructions.
- 2. Flush Mount vs. Bracket Mount: Flush mount fixtures do not include a bracket. They are designed to be mounted directly to the surface. This is our #1 support question and now you know.

Flush Mount Fixtures

Flush Mount fixtures are designed to mount directly to the wall or surface, **not** to an electrical box. This design allows flexibility but does not include a mounting bracket.

- No bracket is needed or included.
- Mounting holes are pre-drilled (.25"), and can be enlarged by your installer.
- Mounting hardware is not included, as surface materials vary.
- Installation should be completed by a licensed professional.

Bracket Mounted Fixtures

Bracket mounted fixtures are designed to be mounted using the **decorative bracket included** with your lantern.

- Brackets cover the electrical box but are not intended to mount directly to it.
- Fixtures are heavy and must be securely attached to the wall surface.
- Installation should be completed by a licensed professional.
- Mounting hardware is not included.
- Installation should be completed by a licensed professional.

Gas Fixture Installation

- · Secure bracket to wall surface.
- · Connect fixture to gas source using code-approved fittings.
- Do not pressure-test the valve it is not rated for high pressure.
- Use Teflon tape or pipe thread compound.
- To ignite: open the valve 1/4 turn, place a lit match near the burner.
- · Adjust flame height as follows:
- 1. Fixtures 21" or less: 1"-1.5" flame
- 2. Fixtures 21" or more: 2"-2.5" flame

Safety Note:

Do not install flush mount gas lanterns on combustible surfaces.

Electric Fixture Installation

- · Remove glass and protective caps.
- Run electrical line through the stem (bracket fixtures).
- Secure bracket to the wall and connect wiring.
- Only use Type A19 bulbs, 75 watts or less.
- Installation must follow all local codes and be performed by a licensed electrician.

Trouble-Shooting Tips

- If the flame keeps going out, check for broken glass or water intrusion.
- Condensation or gas line debris may block flow have a professional clear the line.
