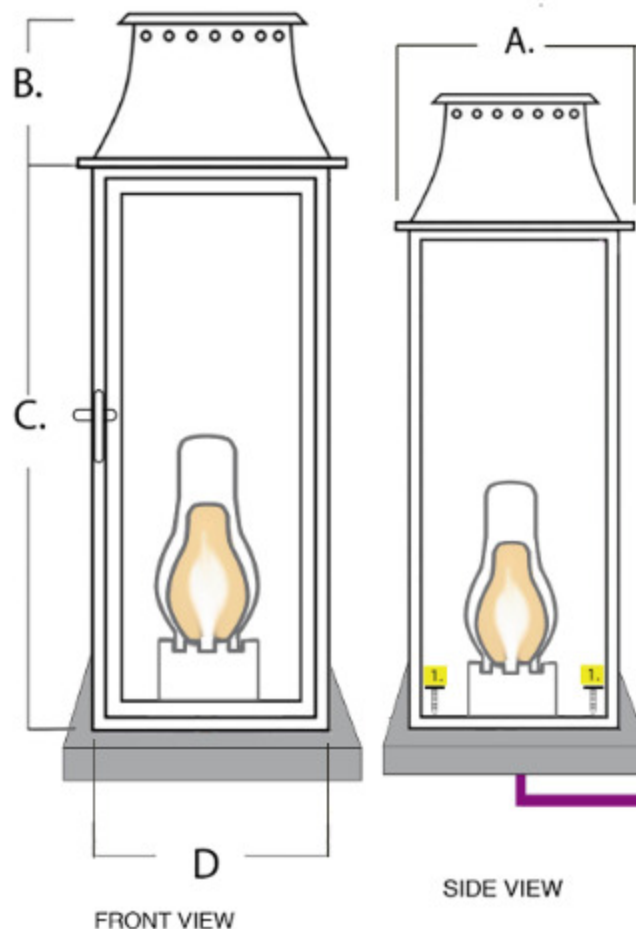


Colonial Column Mount - Electric

Available in sizes 13" and up

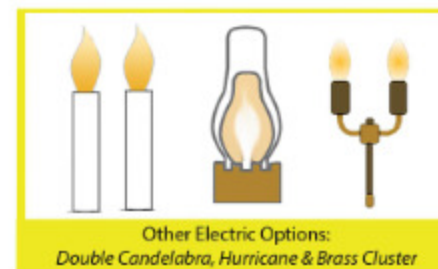


1. The suggested mounting location is from within the lantern. The installer must drill a mounting hole at the bottom of the lantern and securely attach it to the existing structure. Pre-drilled holes are not provided, as many columns have open spaces underneath that contain essential plumbing and electrical components. We do not supply fasteners because these lanterns can be mounted on different surfaces. If you are in a salt-air environment, we highly recommend using corrosion-resistant fasteners.
